“Jesus appeared again to the disciples beside the sea of Galilee. Seven of the disciples were there and Simon Peter said, ‘I’m going fishing.’ We’ll come too they all said. So they went out in the boat but even though they fished all night, they caught nothing. At dawn the disciples saw a man standing on the shore but they couldn’t see it was Jesus. He called out, ‘Friends, have you caught any fish?’ ‘Not a thing!’ they replied.’ Then Jesus said, ‘Throw out your net on the right-hand side of the boat, and you’ll get plenty of fish! So they did what Jesus said to do, and they instantly caught so many fish, they couldn’t even draw in the net because it was so full of fish! Then John said to Peter, ‘IT’S THE LORD!’ When Peter realized that he put on his tunic, jumped into the water, and swam ashore, leaving the others in the boat to pull the loaded net to the shore, for they were only out about three hundred feet. When they got to shore they saw that Jesus was cooking fish and bread over a charcoal fire. Jesus said, ‘Bring some of the fish you just caught.’ So Peter went back aboard and dragged the net ashore. It was filled with 153 large fish, and yet the net had not torn. Now they were sure it really was the Lord! Then Jesus served them the bread and the fish. This was the third time Jesus had appeared to his disciples since he had been raised from the dead.” – John 14:1-14 (LB)
