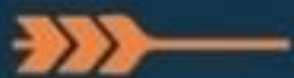

So he called one of the servants and asked him what was going on.”

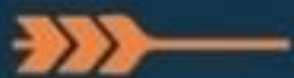
Characteristics of the Prodigal Son's Father:

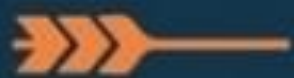


***“But he answered to his father,
